1. Purpose of the position

This position is an operational position within the Customs and Taxation Department of the IGA Ministry of Finance. It has the responsibility for enforcing laws and treaties regarding the importation and export of goods, detecting instances of infringement or non-compliance with regulations, and taking the necessary steps to enforce the laws.

Duties include carrying out inspections, combating the importation of firearms, drugs and other banned items and identifying goods on which duties must be paid, working with revenue officers to collect customs and excise duties. Liasing with other agencies to collect analyse and act on intelligence regarding possible attempts to import or export illegally.

- Degree qualification is not a requirement.
- Training and experience in law enforcement. necessary
- Training in international trade. necessary
- Associate Degree in Business Administration/Accounting, Economics and/or Financial Management- desirable , not essential
