1. Background

The Federal Republic of Somalia has received financing from the African Development Bank towards the cost of implementing the Institutional Support for Economic Governance Project (ISEGP) to strengthen domestic revenue mobilization, public expenditure management, and accountability for greater economic resilience in Somalia. The project has three components, namely: (i) enhancing domestic resource mobilization; (ii) improving public expenditure and debt management; and (iii) Strengthening capacity for project management.

The Ministry of Finance thus intends to apply part of the agreed amount for this grant to hire a consultancy firm to National Anti-Corruption Strategy Development for the Ministry of Justice and Constitutional Affairs of the Federal Republic of Somalia.

2. Scope of the assignment: This consultancy service is to support the Ministry of Justice and Constitutional Affairs of the Federal Republic of Somalia in developing the National Anti-Corruption Strategy. A Consulting firm will be selected in accordance with the **Quality and Cost Based Selections (QCBS) method**.

3. Duration: The strategy and other deliverables are envisaged to be prepared within starting from the contract's signing date. The consultant will be expected to finalize and submit the final strategy within this period, which will be spread across 18 months.

4. The Ministry of Ministry of Finance now invites eligible consultancy firms to indicate their interest in providing these services. Interested consultancy firms must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services:

1. Core business of the firm and years in business.
2. Specific experience in successfully implementing similar assignments
3. Experience of relevant services in an environment similar to that of Somalia
4. Technical and managerial organization of the firm (provide only the structure of the organization, general qualification, and number of key staff). Do not provide CVs of key staff. Key experts will not be evaluated at the shortlisting stage

5. Eligibility criteria, the establishment of the short-list, and the selection procedure shall be in accordance with the African Development Bank's "**Procurement Policy for Bank Group Funded Operations**", dated October 2015, which is available on the Bank's website at <http://www.afdb.org>.

6. Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications but should indicate clearly whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or a sub-consultancy. In the case of a joint venture, all the partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected.
