- 1. The Federal Government of Somalia through the Ministry of Finance has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of Somalia Urban Resilience Project II (SURPII) and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the Contract for Construction of Sheikh Hassan Barsane Road (Suuqa Xoolaha to Burjada Cinta): KM0+000 to KM3+000 Beledweyne Municipality. For this contract, the Borrower shall process the payments using the Direct Payment disbursement method, as defined in the World Bank's Disbursement Guidelines for Investment Project Financing.
- 2. The Beledweyne Municipality now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for the Contract for Construction of Sheikh Hassan Barsane Road (Suuqa Xoolaha to Burjada Cinta): KM0+000 to KM3+000 Beledweyne Municipality.
- 3. The scope of the work include but not limited to:
 - Construction of diversions and allowing for passage of traffic.
 - Site clearance and top layer stripping.
 - Earthworks (approx. 75,100 m³)
 - Structural excavation (9,200 m³), construction of different sizes of concrete pipe culverts of various diameters (110 m) including headwalls, wing walls and storm drainage works.
 - Construction in cubic meters subbase 36,000 m²) and base course (35,000 m²).
 - Asphalt surfacing Prime Coat (31,000 m²) and asphalt concrete (3,150 m³).
 - Road furniture (precast concrete curbstone, traffic signs, guard rails, handrails, and safety barriers).
 - Other appurtenant facilities as shown in the bidding document.

The construction period will be 14 months and a Defects Liability Period of Twelve (12) months.

- 4. Bidding will be conducted through open national competitive procurement using a Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement_Regulations for IPF Borrowers" dated July 2016, revised November 2017, August 2018, November 2020 and updated September 2023 ("Procurement Regulations"), and is open to all Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.

- 7. A virtual pre-bid meeting shall be conducted by the Employer on 9th January 2025 at 10:30am Mogadishu time.
- 8. Electronic Bidding will be permitted. Late Bids will be rejected
- 9. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before 20th January 2025 at 10:30am Mogadishu time. Electronic Bidding will be permitted. Bids must be encrypted using a password that will be provided by participating bidders on 20th January 2025 at 10:30am Mogadishu time. Bids submitted after the deadline will be rejected and submitted bids whose password not received on specified deadline will not be opened and will be rejected and returned to the bidders unopened. Bidders will receive a Google Meet or Zoom invitation to the public opening of bids on 20th January 2025 10:30am Mogadishu time in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives and anyone else who wishes to attend at the address below.
- 10. All Bids must be accompanied by a **Bid-Securing Declaration using the form included** in **Section IV**, **Bidding Forms**.
