1. The **Government of Somalia** has received financing from the World Bank towards the cost of the **Somalia Urban Resilience Project II (SURP II)**, and intends to apply part of the proceeds towards payments under the contract for **Construction of Baidoa Town Roads Package 3A: Baidoa Main Road**. For this contract, the Borrower shall process the payments using the Direct Payment disbursement method, as defined in the World Bank's Disbursement Guidelines for Investment Project Financing.

2. The **Municipality of Baidoa** now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for the Construction a 1.95Km, 14m wide dual carriageway road, 0.52Km, 11.5m wide single carriageway road section, concrete lined side drains, streetlights and 1.5m wide sidewalks in the City of Baidoa. The Scope of Works includes but is not limited to:

- Site clearance and topsoil stripping
- Earthworks
- Construction of sub-base (200 mm)
- Stabilized gravel base (150 mm)
- Asphalt concrete surfacing (50 mm)

- Construction of roundabouts and junctions at intersections with other roads.
- Lined side drains (Concrete lined drains, approx. 5,000m)
- Pipe culverts
- Sidewalks with concrete paving blocks (approx. 7,500 m2)
- Solar Powered street lighting (approx. 124 poles)
- Road furniture.

The construction period will be **Fourteen (14)** months and a Defects Liability Period of Twelve (12) months.

3. Bidding will be conducted through open national competitive procurement using a Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank’s “Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers” dated **July 1st 2016** revised **November 2017 and August 2018**, November 2020 and September 2023 (“Procurement Regulations”), setting forth the World Bank’s policy on conflict of interest and is open to all Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
